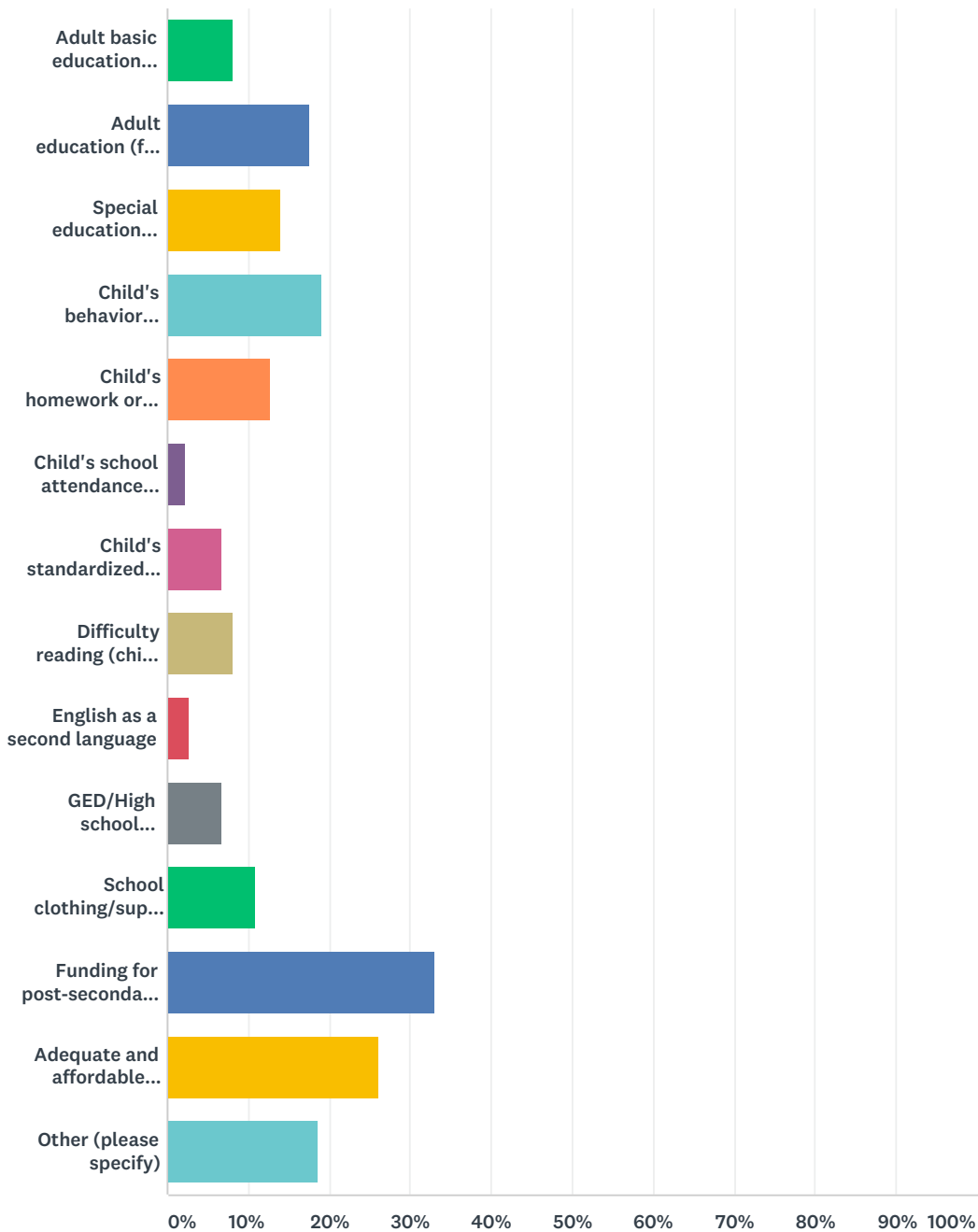


# Q1 Do you or anyone in your household have any of the following school-related needs? (select all that apply)

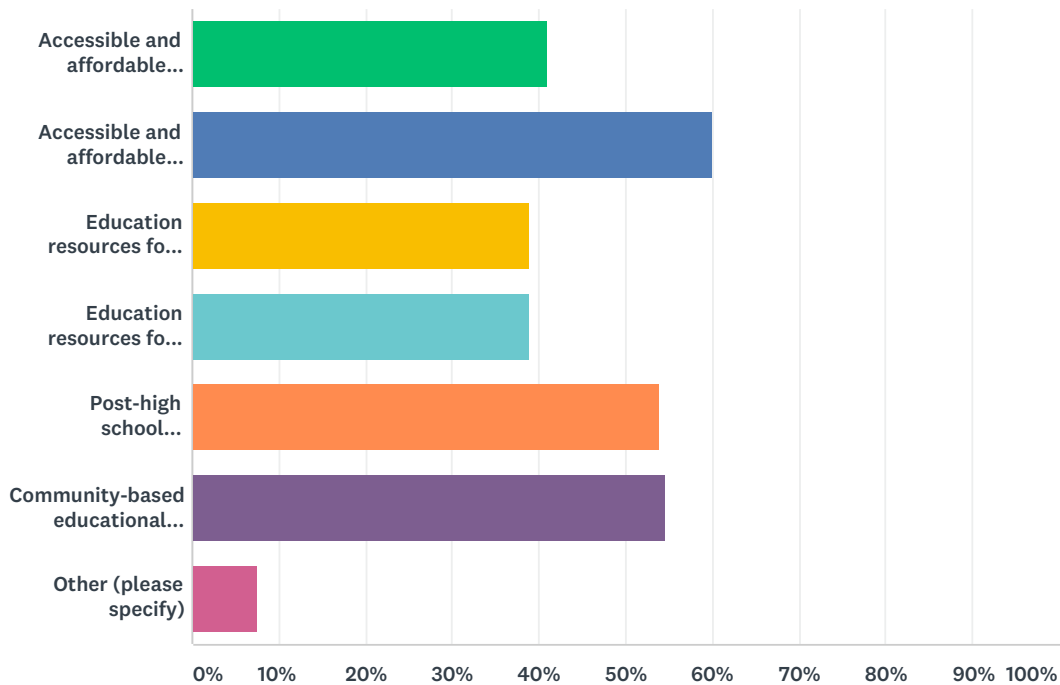

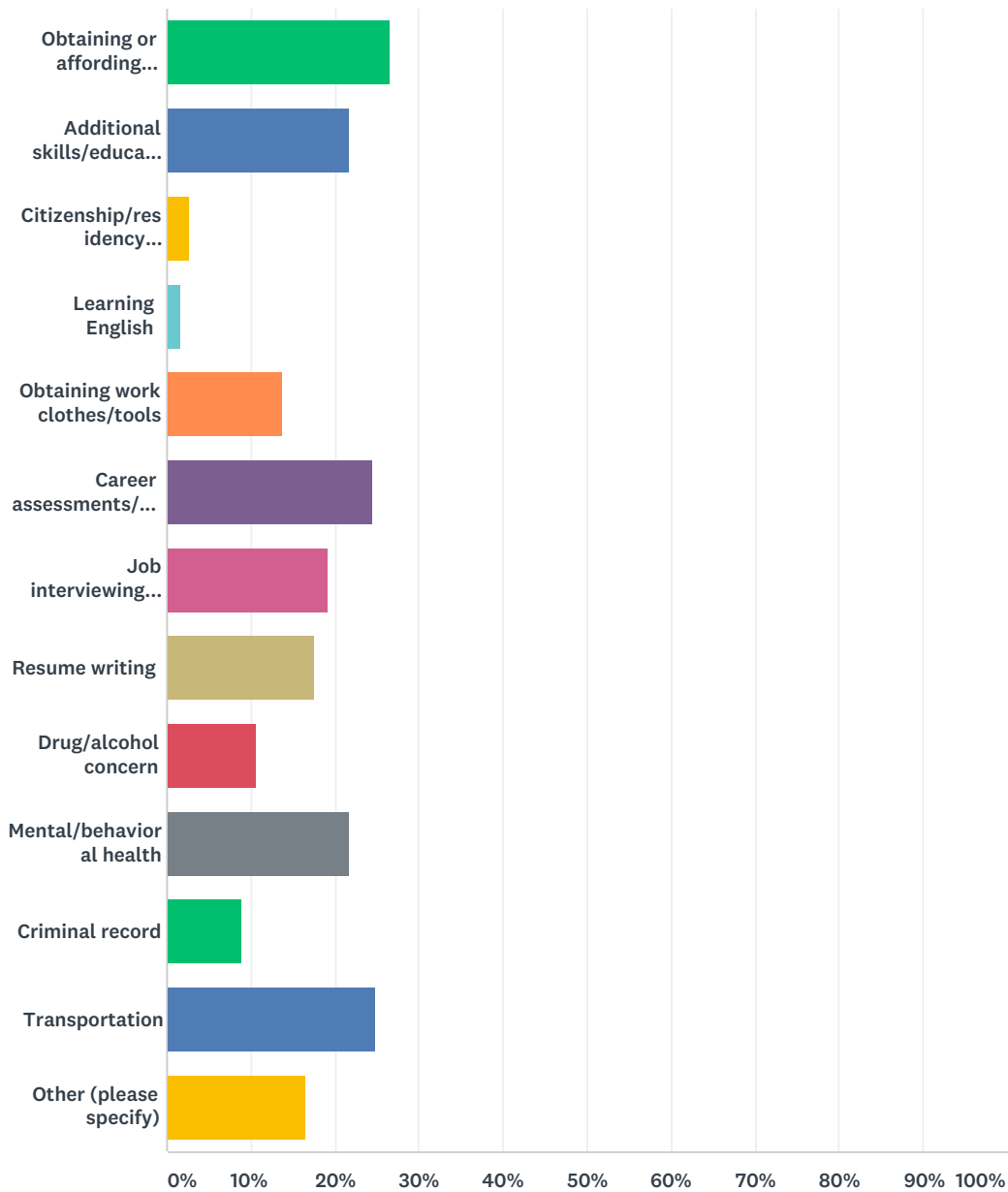

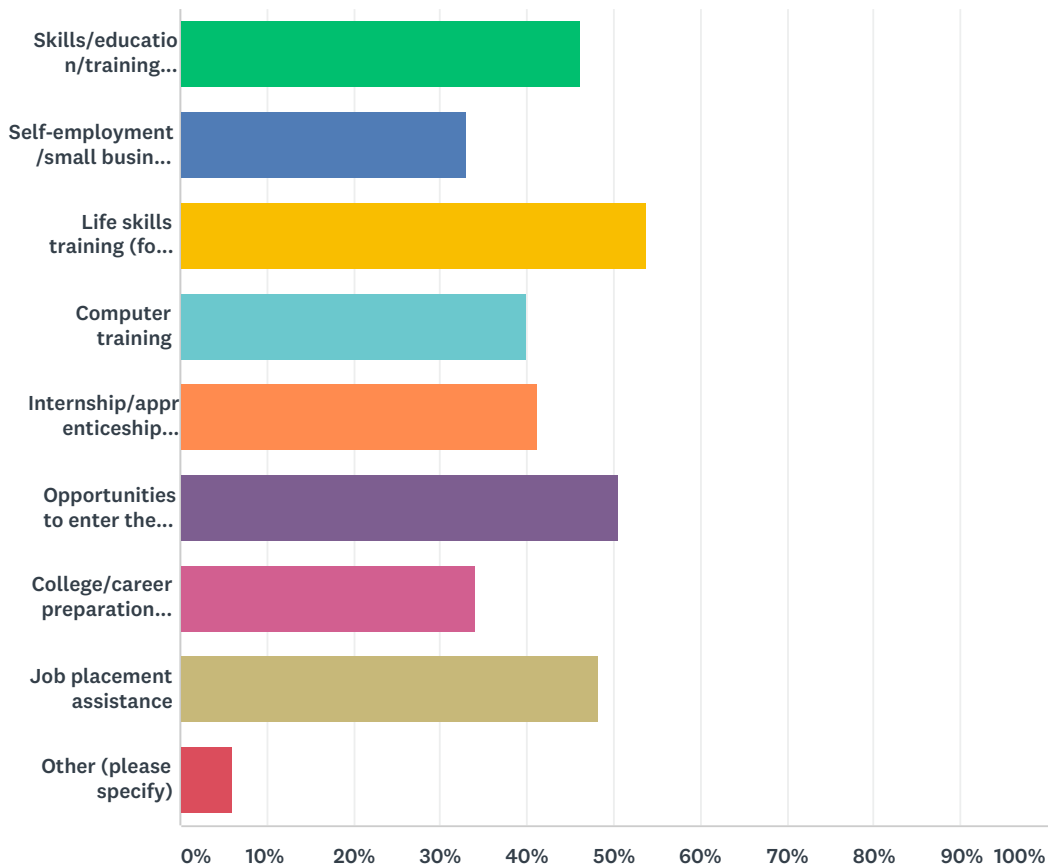

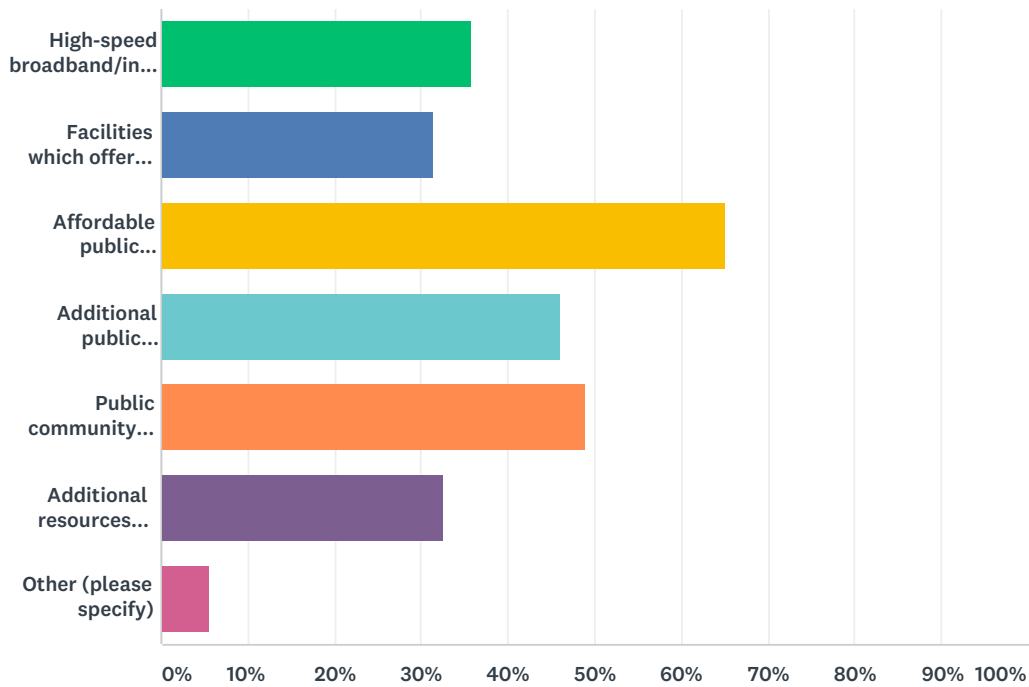

### Q5 In Butler County, which of the following community facilities and services are needed? (select all that apply)

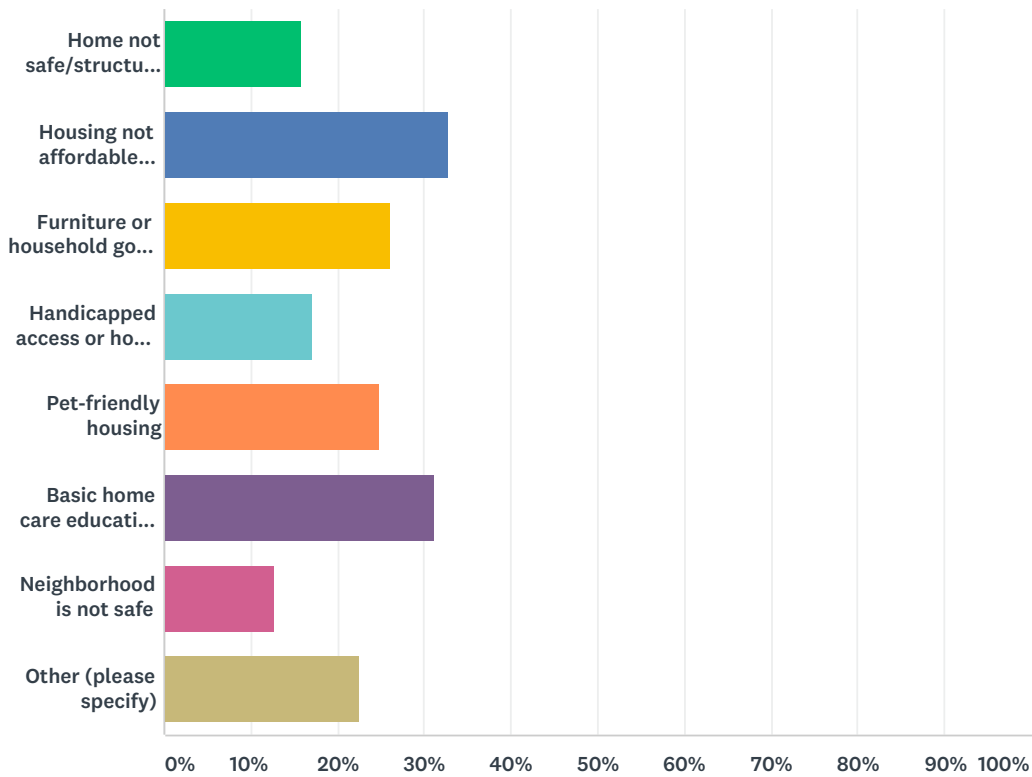

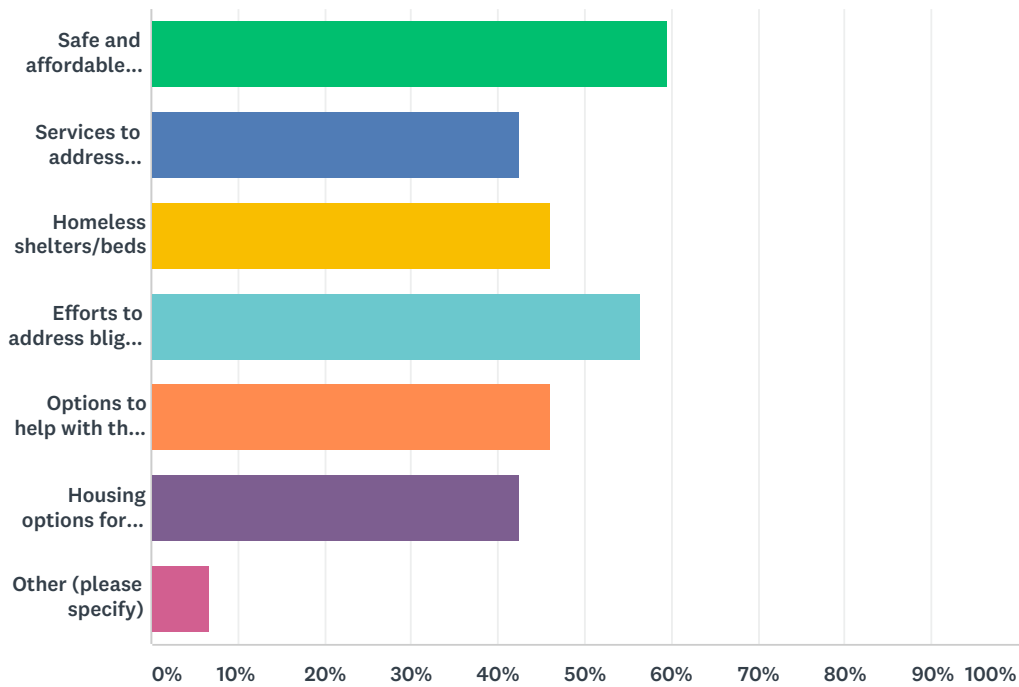

### Q7 In Butler County, which additional housing-related services are needed? (select all that apply)

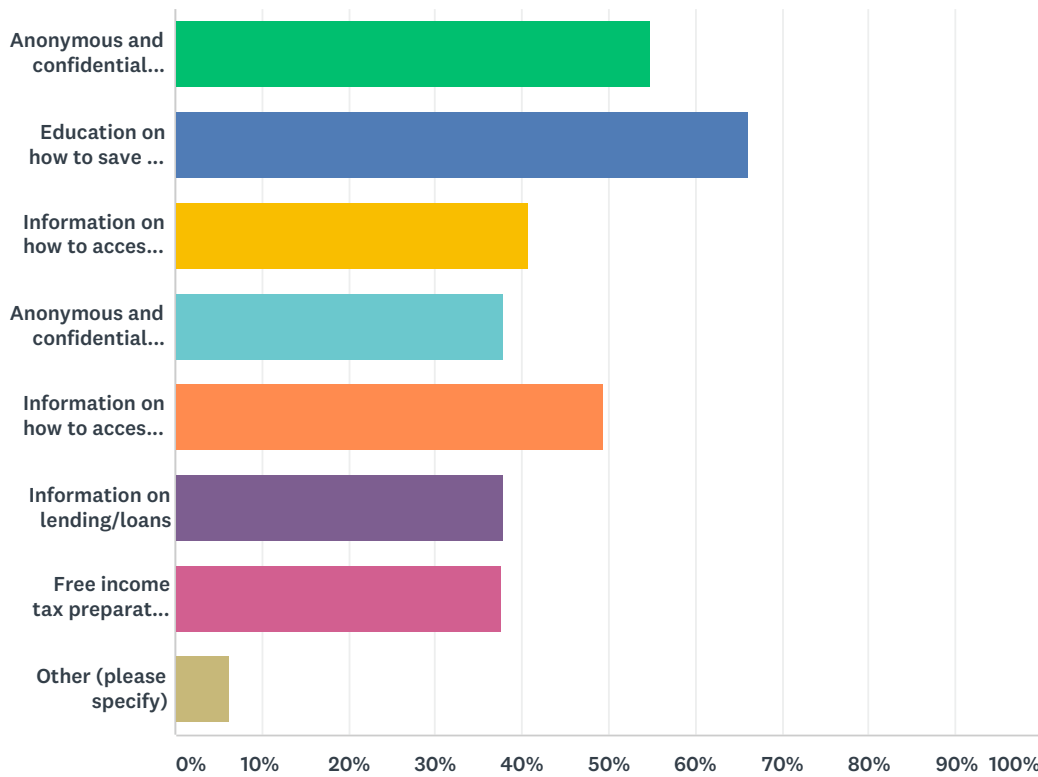

### Q8 In Butler County, which additional income-management and wealth-building services are needed? (select all that apply)

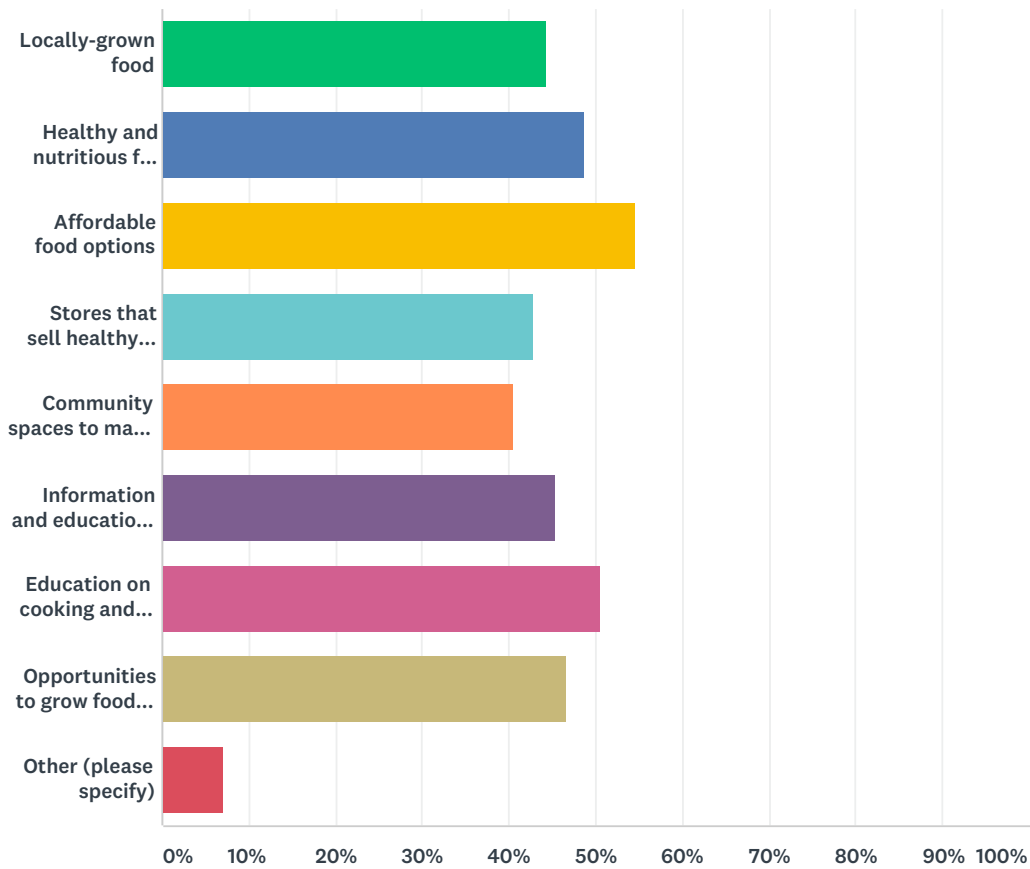

### Q9 In Butler County, which of the following additional food resources are needed? (select all that apply)

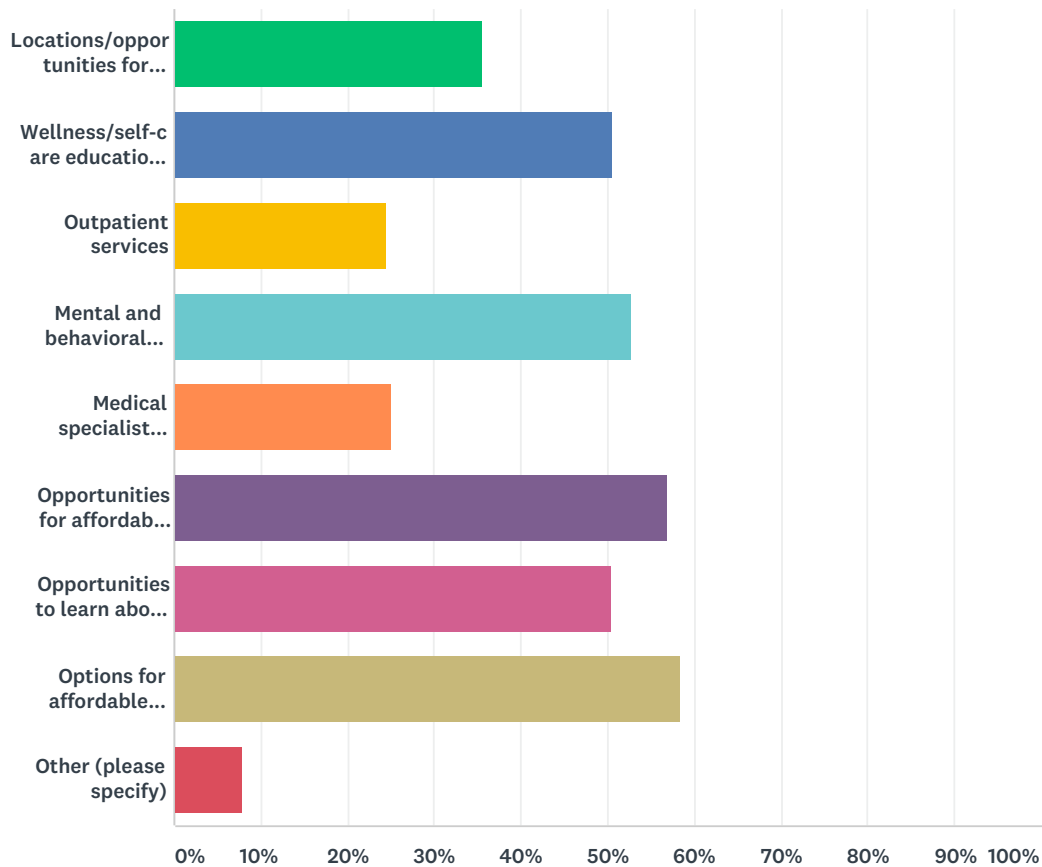

### Q10 In Butler County, which additional physical, behavioral, and mental health services are needed? (select all that apply)

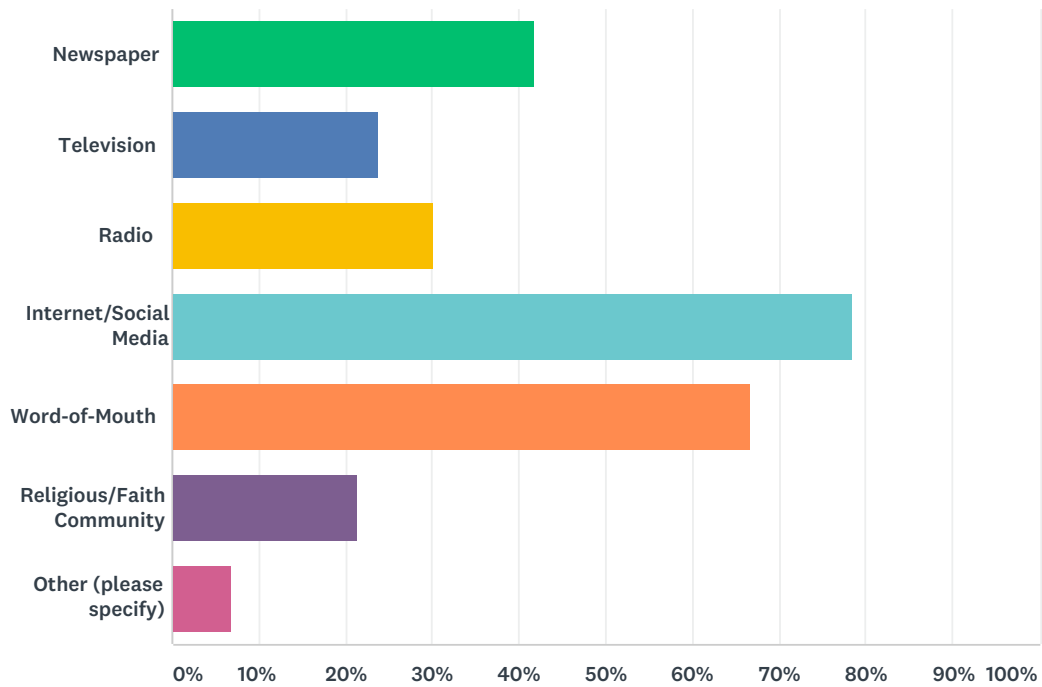

## Q11 How do you find out about events/services in your community? (select all that apply)

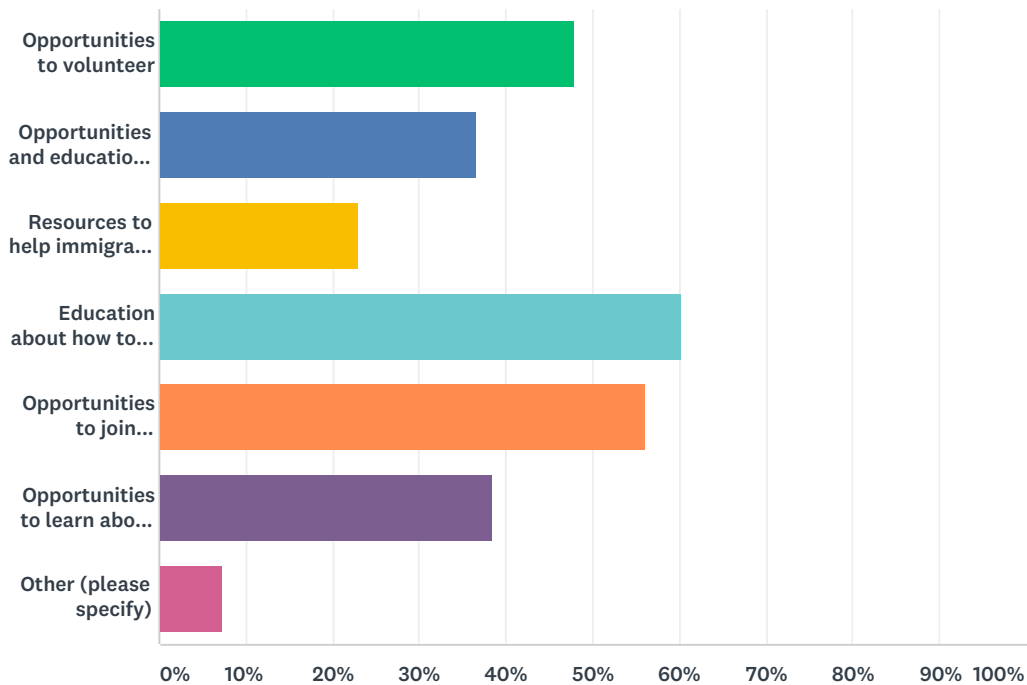

### Q12 In Butler County, which additional opportunities for civic engagement are needed? (select all that apply)

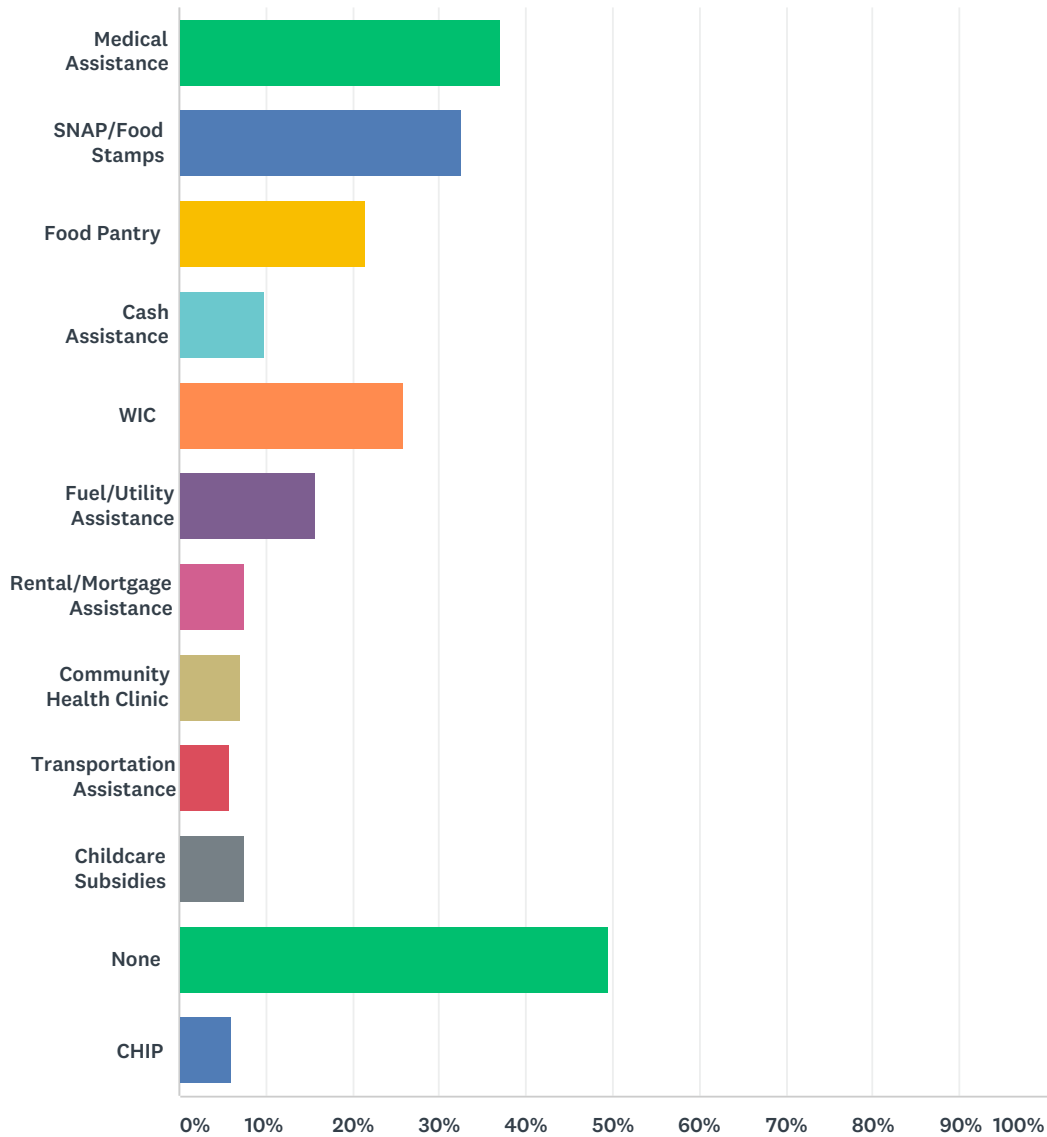

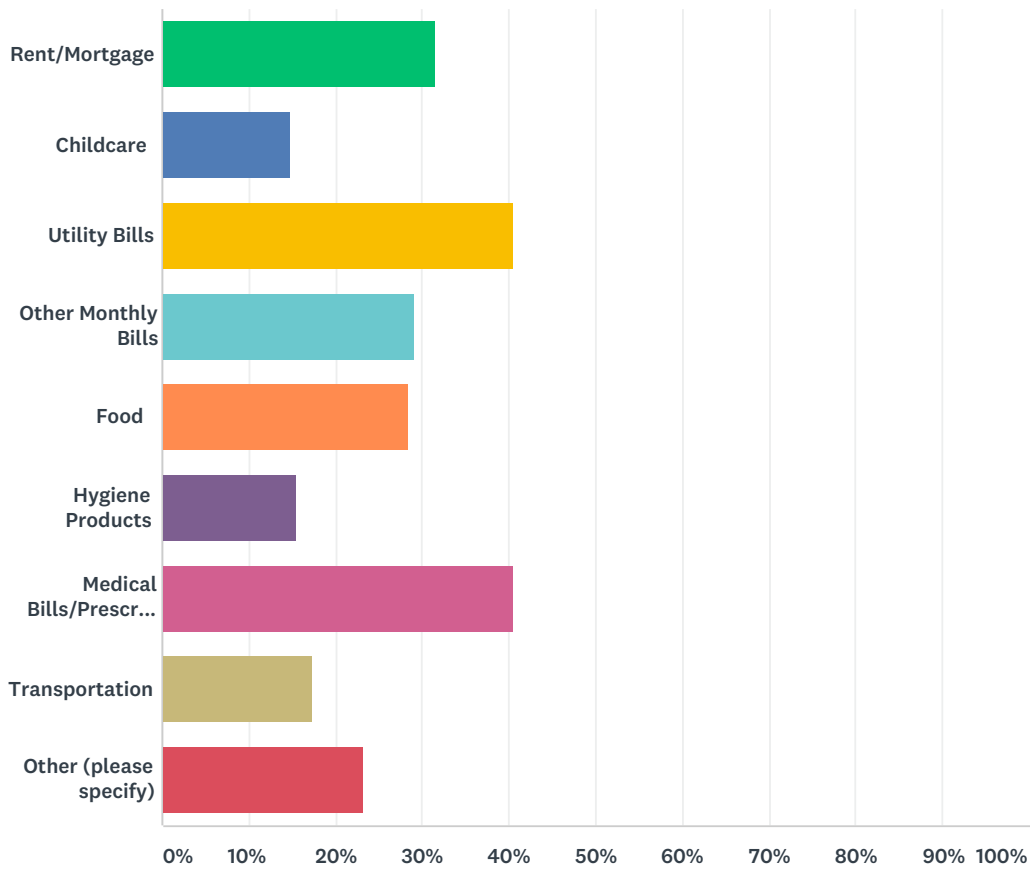

### Q14 Have you or someone in your household fallen behind or not been able to pay for: (select all that apply)

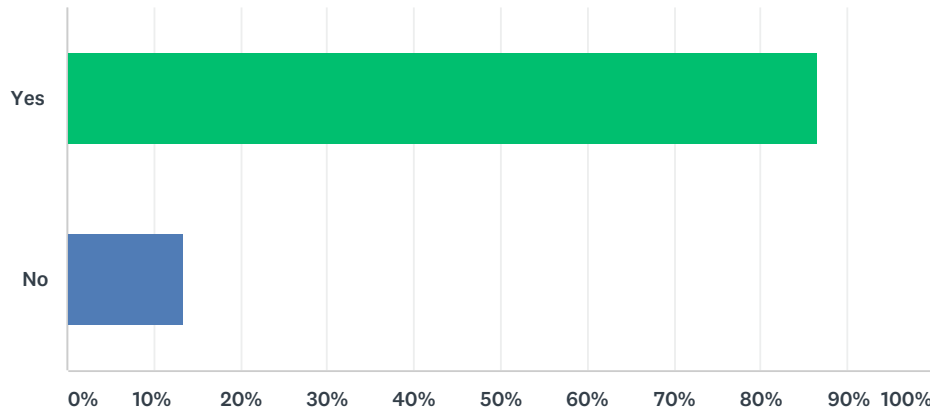

### Q15 Do you have a primary care doctor that you see once a year?

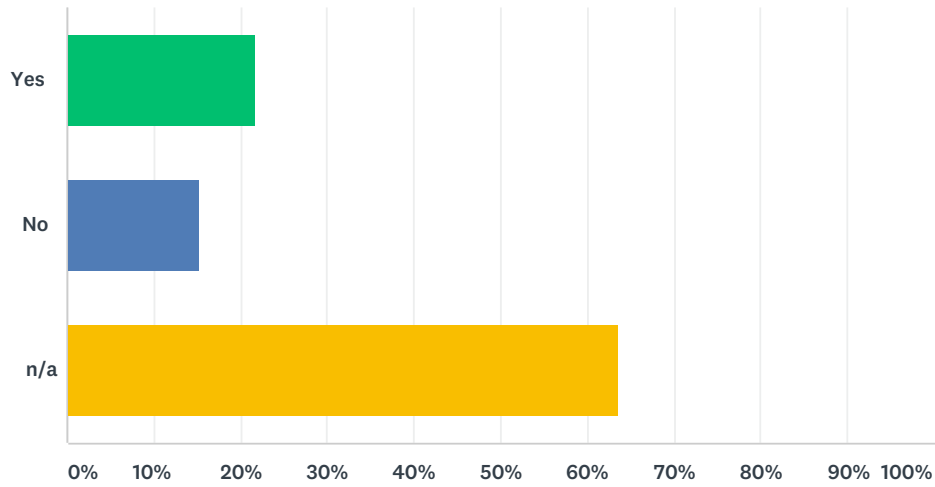

## Q16 Do you have enough access to adequate and affordable childcare?

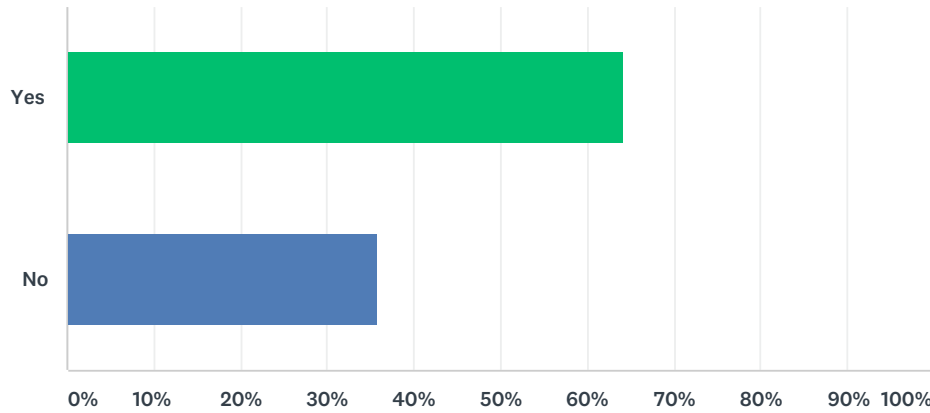

### Q17 Do you know where to go or send someone to get emergency help with food, shelter, paying bills, or other emergency needs?

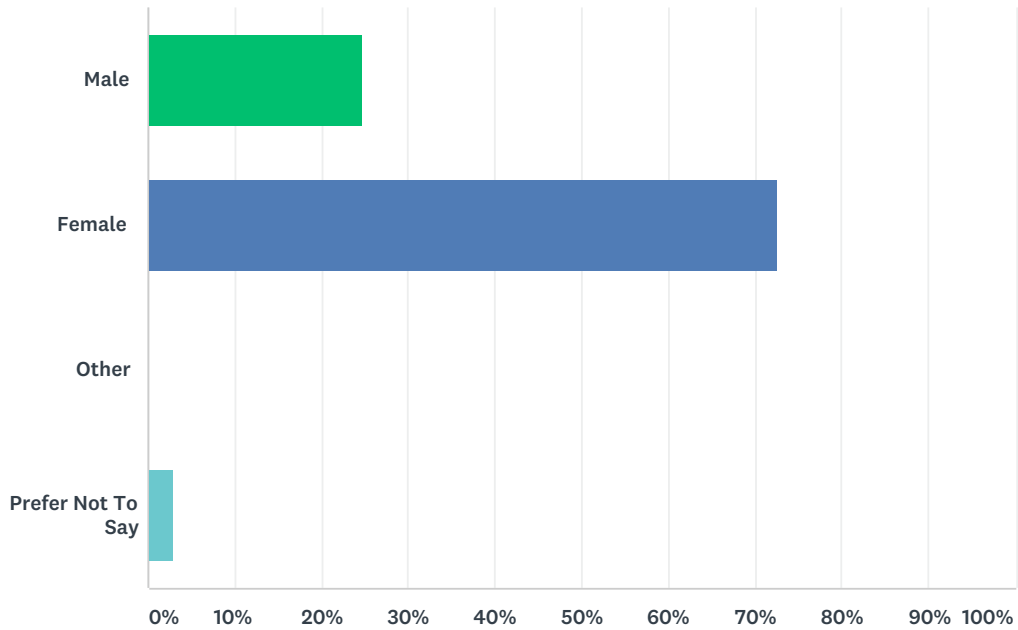

### Q18 What is your gender?

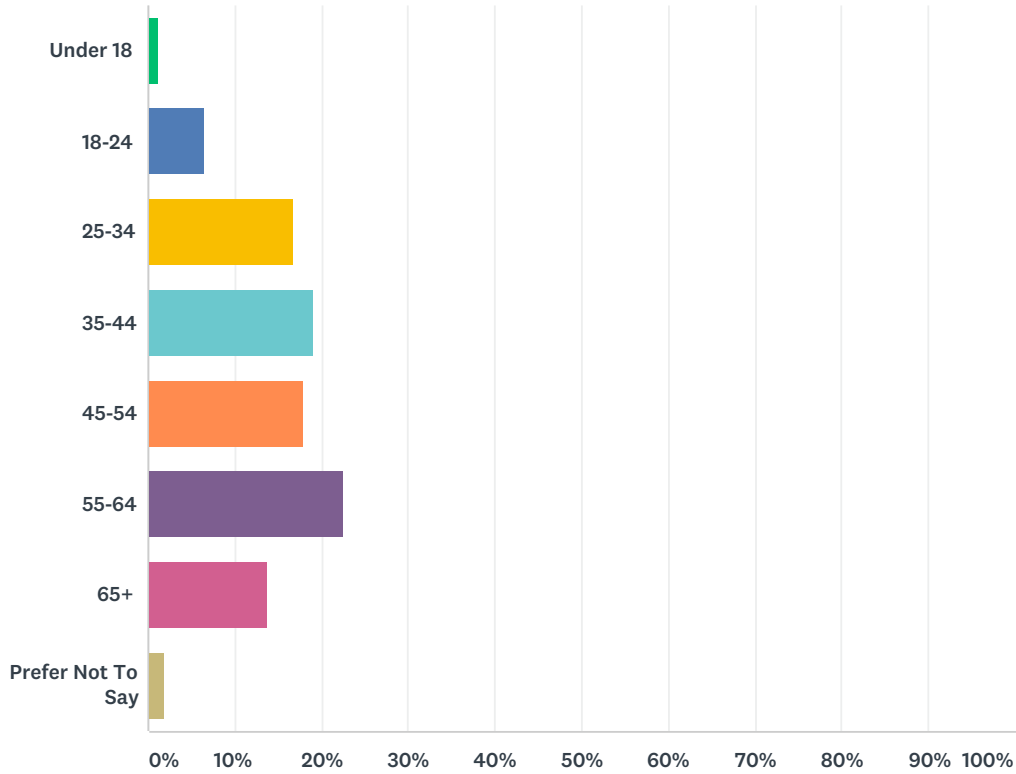

### Q19 What is your age?

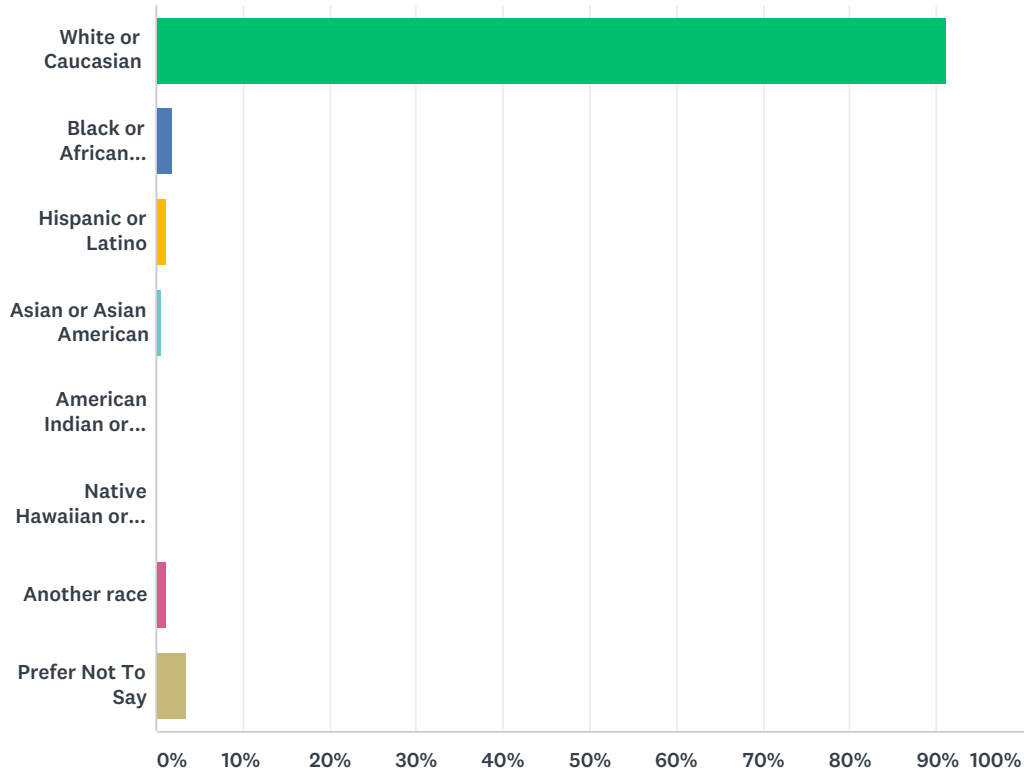

## Q20 What is your race?

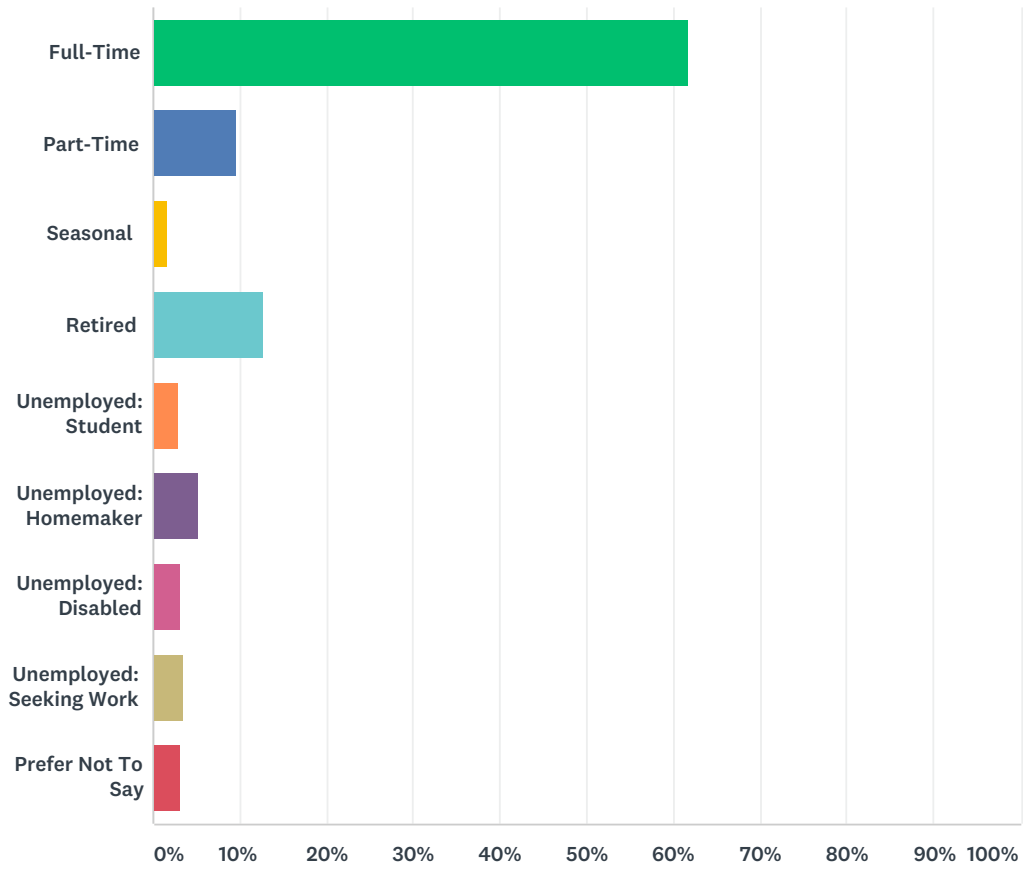

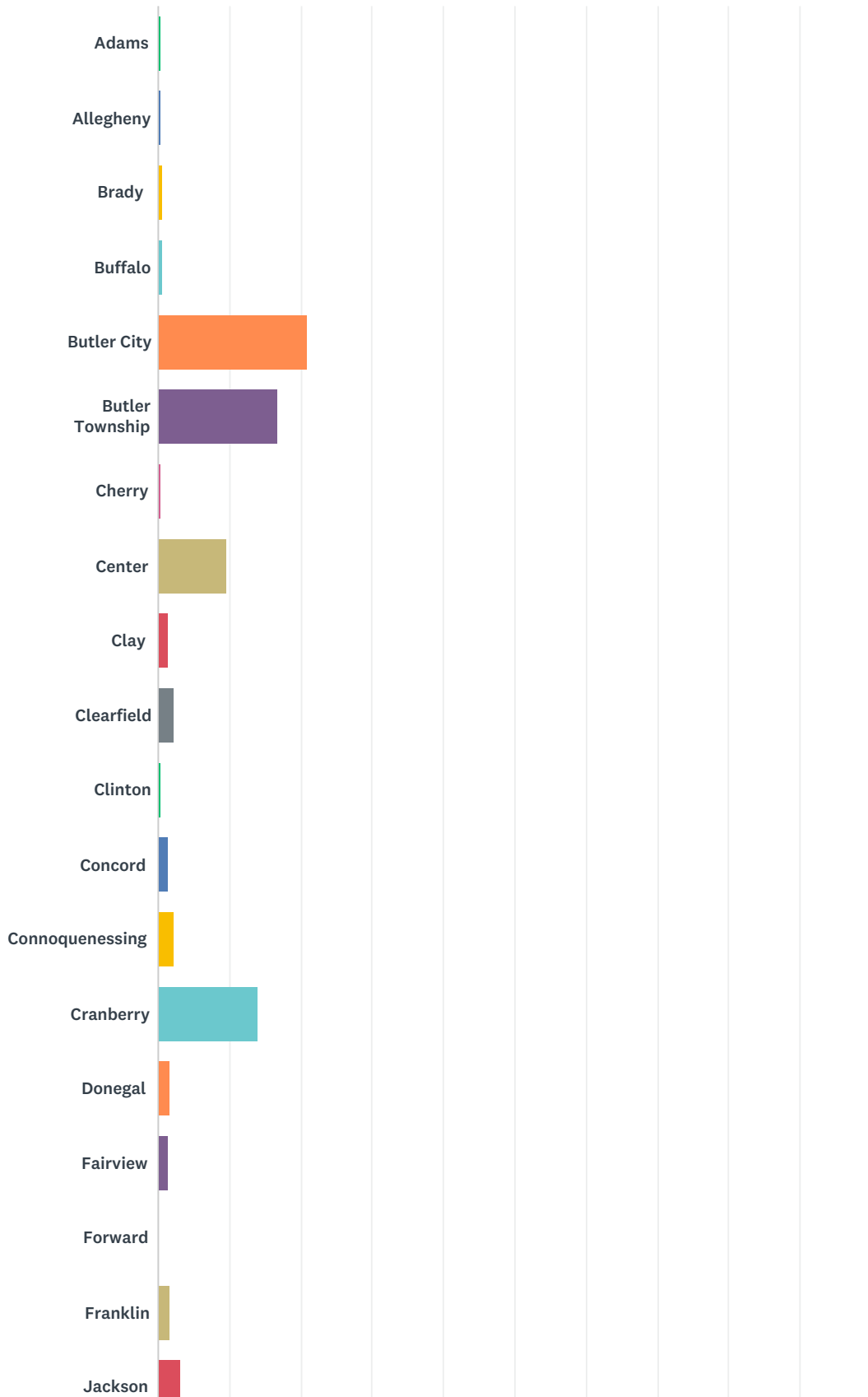


## Q22 What is your zip code?

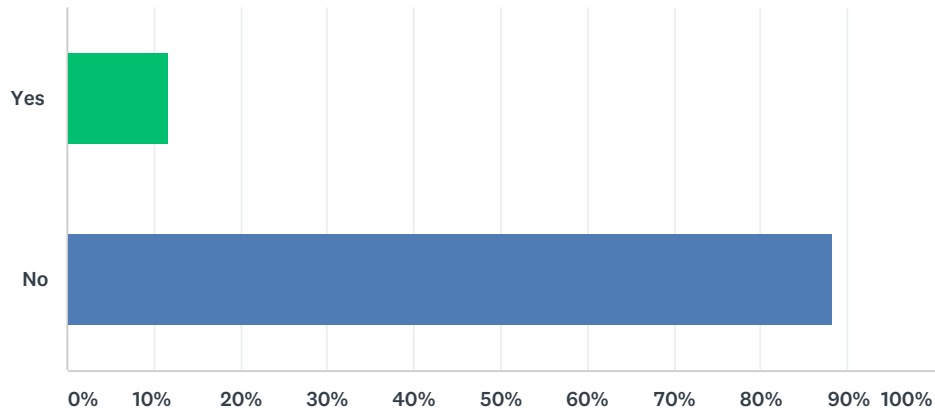

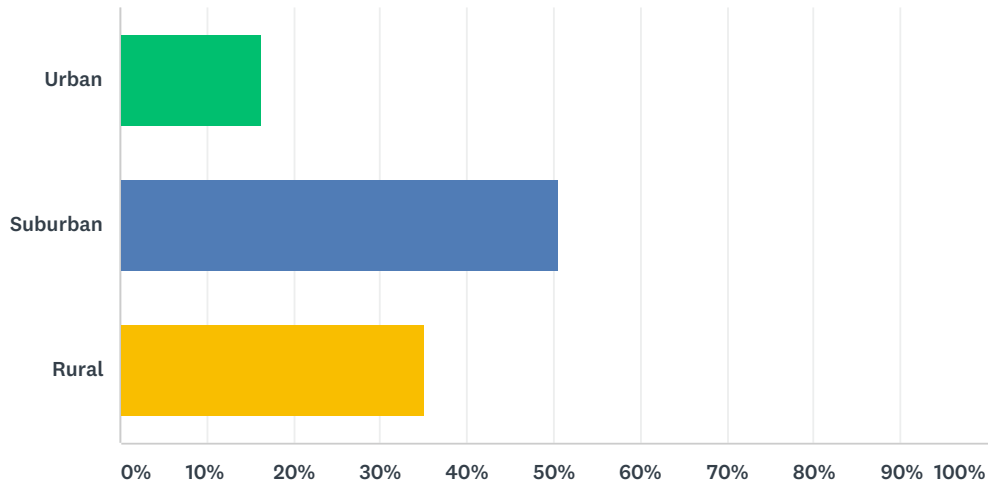

## Q25 In what type of community do you live?

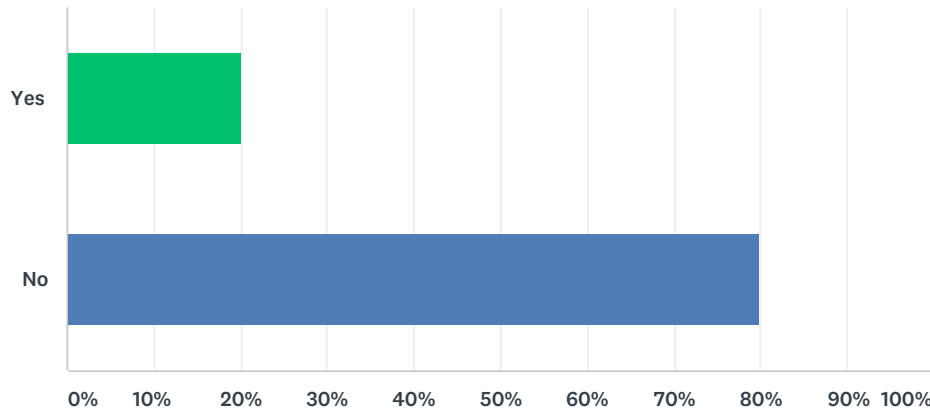

### Q26 Are you or anyone in your household disabled?

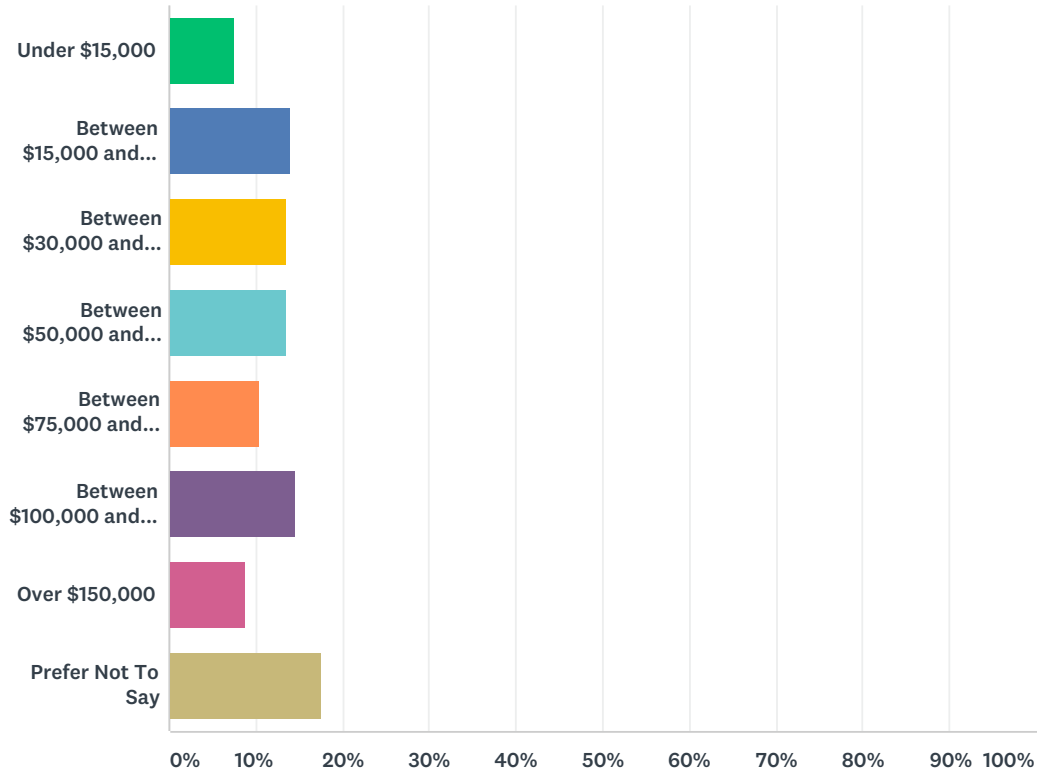

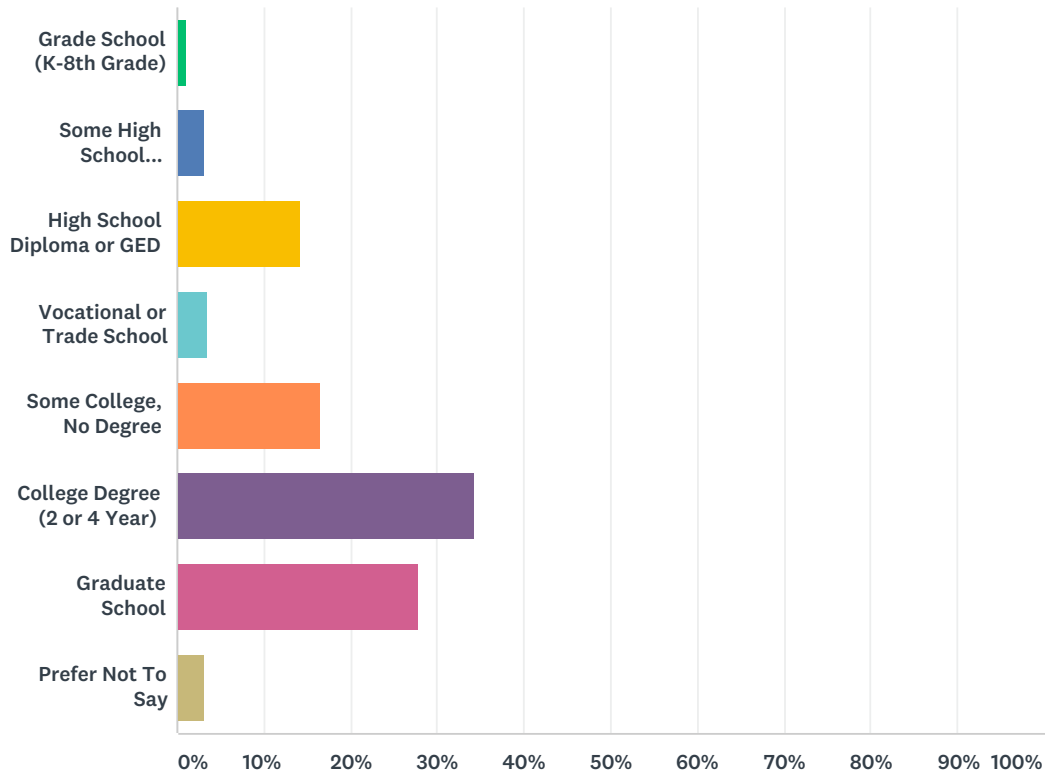

## Q28 What is the highest grade you completed in school?

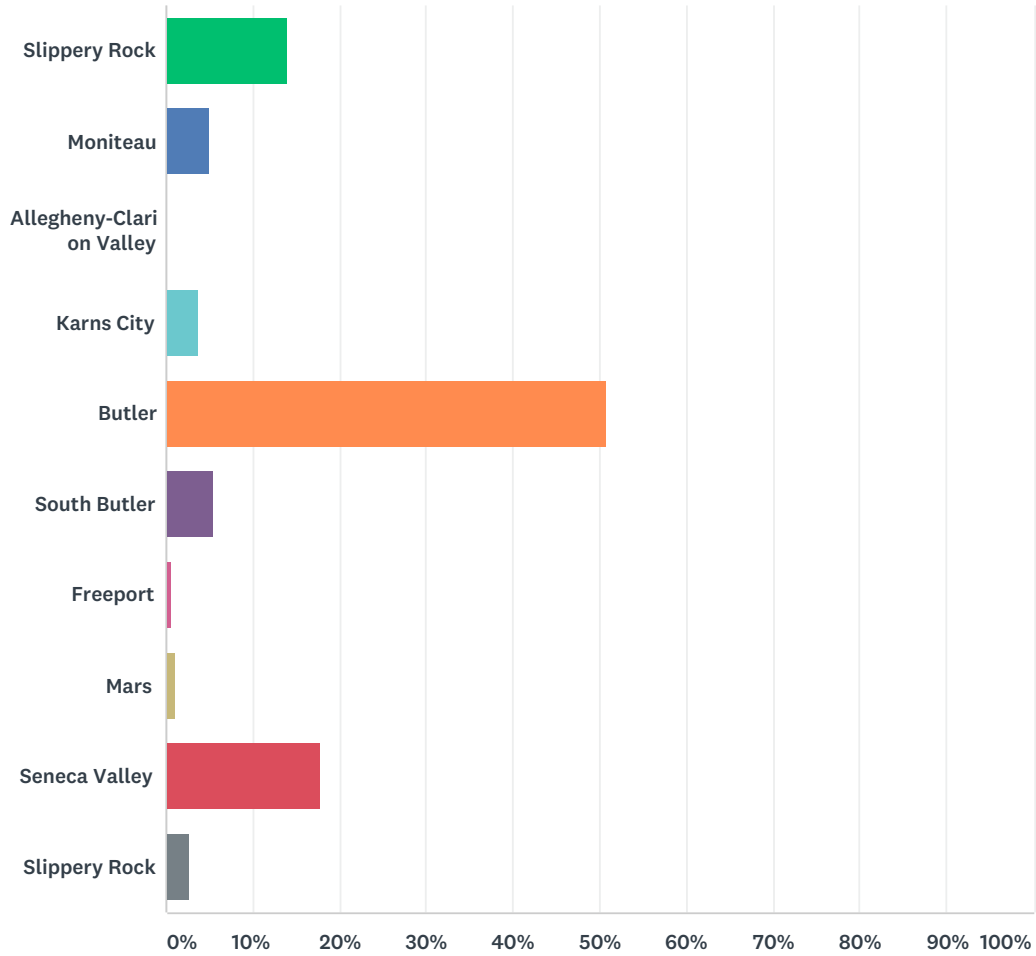
